It was great to see everyone back ready for a whirlwind term! Teachers will be finalising end of year assessments so they are able to write reports on student progress and achievement. It is pleasing to see the students engaging positively in all areas of the school curriculum.

As at 11.59pm on Monday 25 October 2021 the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order for Mandatory Vaccinations for Education came into effect.

From 1 January 2022, schools must only allow those that are fully vaccinated to provide onsite services. This also includes unpaid workers, such as volunteers and any members of the community who are regularly on site during a time when students may be present.

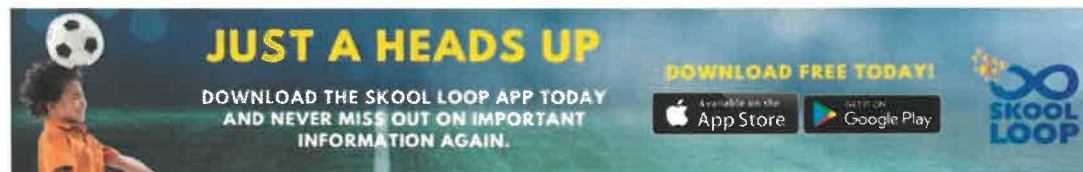
The vaccination requirements apply wherever in-person schooling occurs, not only on the school grounds or early learning service sites, but also at school camps, swimming pools, museums, or where other education outside the classroom (EOTC) programmes take place. This means that both school staff and volunteers who are involved in EOTC should have had a first vaccination by 15 November and be fully vaccinated by 1 January 2022.

The requirements do not apply to people who are visiting our school, such as for a learning conference or a parent, whānau and community evening.
